  - A. Matthew 26:69-75
  - B. Luke 22:60-62

  - A. John 18:28-40
  - B. Luke 23:1-5
- V. JESUS WAS TAKEN BEFORE HEROD (Luke 23:6-12)
- VI. JESUS WAS TAKEN BEFORE PILATE AGAIN (Matthew 27:15-31)
