(Lesson 12)

Introduction:

1. By studying "The Story of Jesus" as it is revealed in the Scriptures (John 5:39), we are able to grow in the knowledge of Christ (2 Peter 3:18).

 - B. Blasphemy was punishable by death (Leviticus 24:16).
- III. AS JESUS WAS BEING TRIED, PETER DENIED HIM
 - A. Matthew 26:69-75
 - B. Luke 22:60-62
- IV. JESUS WAS TAKEN BEFORE PILATE
 - A. John 18:28-40
 - B. Luke 23:1-5
- V. JESUS WAS TAKEN BEFORE HEROD (Luke 23:6-12)
- VI. JESUS WAS TAKEN BEFORE PILATE AGAIN (Matthew 27:15-31)
